
CAMELLIA FLOWER FORMS



- (1) <u>SINGLE</u>: 1row of up to 8 petals with prominent stamens, forming usually saucer-shaped or occasionally cup- or trumpet-shaped flowers.
- (2) <u>SEMI-DOUBLE</u>: 2 or more rows of large, outer petals, the centre regular, irregular, or composed of loose petals
- (3) ANEMONE-FORM: 1 or more rows of outer petals, with very small petals and stamens in the centre.
- (4) <u>PEONY-FORM</u>: A convex mass of petals, very little petals and stamens. In some forms the stamens may be hidden.
- (5) ROSE-FORM DOUBLE: Overlapping petals showing stamens in a concave centre in the centre.
- (6) FORMAL DOUBLE: Rows of overlapping petals and no stamens visible.
