

GRAYSHOTT GARDENERS SUMMER SHOW TROPHIES

Davies Rose Cup

A solid silver cup presented to the society in 1984 by the Chairman, Major Davies to be awarded to the exhibitor gaining the most points in the Rose classes.

Smith Cup

A silver plated cup possibly presented by Jack Smith and was won for the first time in 1976. To be awarded to the exhibitor gaining the most points in the Plants, Flowers, Pot/Container classes.

Davies Tankard

A silver-plated tankard presented to the Society in 1982 by the Chairman Major Davies and is awarded to the exhibitor gaining the most points in the Fruit and Vegetable classes.

Mike Hallt Cup

A solid silver bowl mounted on a wooden stand, designed and made by Peter Penfold, former Society Treasurer. It was presented to the Society in 2006 by the Chairman Olive Robinson in memory of Mike Hallt a committed vegetable grower and committee member who believed passionately in the teaching of gardening to children and helped maintain the local school allotment. It is awarded to the winning exhibit in the Potato Championship.

Littlejohn Rose Bowl

A solid silver bowl presented in 1962 by Miss E M Littlejohn thought to be in memory of her sister. Both ladies were keen gardeners and members of the Society. It is awarded to the exhibitor gaining most points across all grown entries except Floral Arrangement.

Novice Cup

A solid silver cup previously known as the Challenge Cup and first awarded in 1924 to J A Winchester for the best kept garden. It lay dormant until 1973 when it became the Novice Cup and is awarded to the exhibitor with the highest number of points in the flower, fruit and vegetable classes who has never won before. It may only be won once.

Floral Arrangement Trophy

A silver plated trophy it was won for the first time in 1969 to May Scrace who went on to win the trophy a further 12 times.

Home Produce Cup

A silver plated cup awarded annually since 1965 to the exhibitor with most points in the Home Produce classes.

Best in Show Plate

Awarded to the Best Exhibit in the show.

The Banksian Medal

This medal is awarded by the R.H.S to the exhibitor with the most points in the Fruit, Flower and Vegetable classes.
