





TULIPS SUITABLE FOR SPRING SHOW – Classes 1 - 5

N.B. Tulips only flower well for 1 or 2 years, so it is best to renew bulbs frequently if wanting a good display in pots or to put them in the Show. Check the information given on the packet. Only the following types will flower in early April – and not always then, depending on what the winter weather has been like.

Class 1	SINGLE EARLY TULIPS
These are short-stemmed & have cup-shaped flowers with 1 layer of petals	
	 'Flair'

Class 2	DOUBLE EARLY TULIPS
These are short stemmed and have bowl-shaped flowers with more than 1 layer of petals	
	 'Monte Orange'

Class 3	KAUFMANNIANA TULIPS
----------------	----------------------------

These have short stems and pointed petals. The flowers open to the sun. In the right conditions they can flower well for more than 2 years

Class 4	FOSTERIANA TULIPS
----------------	--------------------------

These are taller and have larger, more pointed flowers than the Single & Double Early tulips

Class 5	GREIGII TULIPS

These have striped or marbled leaves & longer, more pointed flowers than the Single & Double Early tulips
